Projekthalt

The UN and EU terrorist regimes target individuals and entities being suspected of terrorism and their supporting networks. The measures taken against those who are blacklisted include freezing their assets and travel bans. A related and equally important aspect of the regime is the lack of basic due process rights for persons put on the blacklists.

Ergebnisse

Students began assisting ECCHR lawyers on cases of clients wishing to challenge their designation on the 'terror lists'. Students then developed a legal analysis of the proposal of like minded states, analysing whether it was in accordance with human rights standards enunciated by the European Court of Human Rights. The final work was used by an ECCHR lawyer at the UN Security Council in his lobbying work.
